

“Top Scottsdale Doc Helping Women Regain Self Image—Breast Reconstruction to Mommy Makeovers

Dr. Bryan Gawley, recently named one of Scottsdale’s TOP DOC’s in Phoenix Magazine, is using his surgical skill and talents to give woman back their self-image and self-esteem. Whether it be recreating a breast lost from cancer, or restoring a woman’s breast and tummy shape to their pre-pregnancy form, Dr. Gawley finds these procedures to be some of the most rewarding surgeries he performs.

Dealing with the diagnosis of breast cancer can be overwhelming from so many standpoints. “These woman simultaneously are dealing with the concept of having cancer, the prolonged treatment involved, as well as the potential loss of body image that often comes with mastectomy. Being able to give these patients hope and a restored sense self esteem, and body image is tremendously rewarding.” “I feel priviledged when woman choose me as their surgeon. “ Either through the use of a tissue stretching device called a tissue expander followed by and implant, or sometimes with the use of a woman’s tummy tissue, he is able to shape and mold a new breast for these patients.

Not unlike the effects of breast cancer, pregnancy also takes a tremendous toll on a woman’s body both physiologically (during pregnancy)and anatomically after preganancy causing remarkable changes in the appearance of a womans breasts and abdomen. A mommy makeover is not just one surgery, but typically a combination of surgeries to restore breast shape and fullness along with tummy tuck, liposuction or both to return a womans abdomen back to its prepregnancy form. Not every woman is the same, nor are the end effects of pregnancy. I tailor a specific plan for each patient depending on their individual needs. This may mean either breast augmentation, breast lift, breast reduction or some combination. Most women will need some sort of tummy tuck procedure to tighten the stretched skin and abdominal muscles along with liposuction to help feather and conoutour her hips and curves.
